Argentina

has been set up in St. George, and the bugs are currently being worked out. We expect to begin providing some content for the station soon and hope to be in Grenada in March for planning meetings and for the graduation ceremony of the first GITE class.

Haiti



It has been extremely difficult to minister in Haiti for some time, due to the violence and Covid restrictions. However, the Five Points of Calvinism/Five Solas course has been translated into French, videographed into MP4 format and sent to the bible college and seminary, L'Académie

Théologique de la Réforme d'HAÏTI. Additionally, this month, we shipped about 60 boxes of books and close to 20 bookcases to Haiti for the establishment of the theological library at the new bible college in Jacmel, which will help in gaining national certification for the institution. We also assisted our partner, Reformation Hope, in sending a container of food and supplies to our brothers and sisters in Haiti.

Balkans



We are planning a teaching trip to Bulgaria in May with a vision stopover in Albania. We continue to support Pastor Emanuel Tinev with the church plant in Ruse, Bulgaria near the Romanian border.

Africa



TMI will be sending professors into East Africa in 2022 in partnership with Trinity Biblical Institute, teaching a number of courses in Uganda in their bible college curriculum. They have also asked us to teach some seminars in their training centers in South Sudan, Tanzania,

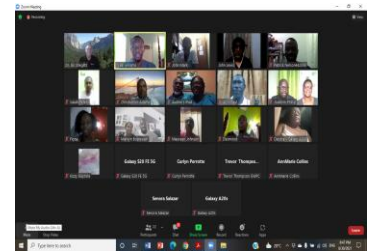
Join Us

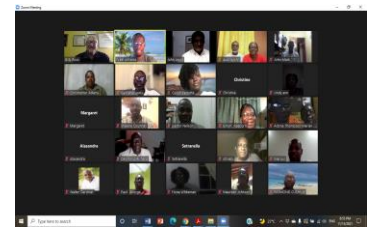
minister, please let us know. We are always looking for new doors the Lord is opening and for new professors to teach in mission fields at home and abroad.
