TMI 2025 Ministry Summary

December 2025 marks almost 13 years of ministry for Teaching Missions International. In our first year, we sent one professor to teach two courses in Haiti. This year, we sent 19 professors to teach 73 courses in 20 countries on four continents to approximately 2,500 participants, mostly pastors and other church leaders. The Lord has richly blessed, expanding our territory dramatically, allowing us to reach many students hungry for the Word of God and the precious truths of the Reformed Faith.

- Hosted our third Southeast Europe Reformed conference in September in Chişinău, Moldova with 67 attendees (up from the 31 in 2024) representing 11 countries throughout the region. This year's theme was Interpreting

and Applying Scripture: The Science of Hermeneutics. Check out the sessions on our website.

- Signed a partnership with Miami International Seminary (MINTS) to become a virtual study center for Haiti and Europe, with further discussion focused on Africa, Western Europe and Nepal. TMI will conduct classes for MINTS via virtual media and face to face, translating courses and readings into French and other languages, recording audio lectures and conducting registrar responsibilities for the Master of Arts in Theological Studies (MATS) and Bachelors of Arts in Theological Studies (BATS) degree programs, with 31 students currently enrolled.
- Supported three church plants in Bulgaria, funded the cost of the ESV study bible notes translation (5-7 year project) into Bulgarian and supported the newly launched Kuyper Center in Buenos Aires, Argentina, which is focused on engaging university students and professors with a Christian worldview. Supported delivering bibles into Nicaragua.
- Worked with our partner, RMNI, to install a radio station in South Sudan, and to install a station in another country. Continued to record content in English that is on Hope 103.1 FM in St. Georges, Grenada and will be broadcast in S. Sudan in 2026. Provided replacement transmitter in Grenada. Continued translating radio content into French.
- All of these accomplishments were made possible only by God's grace and the generous support of our partners in this ministry. We give thanks for your sacrificial giving and trust the Lord for another wonderful year of serving the body of Christ in 2026.

2026 Ministry Plan

- Increase courses taught from 73 to 85 and number of attendees at the SE Europe Reformed Conference to 90+.
- Distribute 1,500 theological books to various countries (increase from 1,300 in 2025).
- Continue to work with Ligonier in translation of Reformed Study Bible notes into Bulgarian with a goal to have completed 17% of the project (up from 2% in 2025).

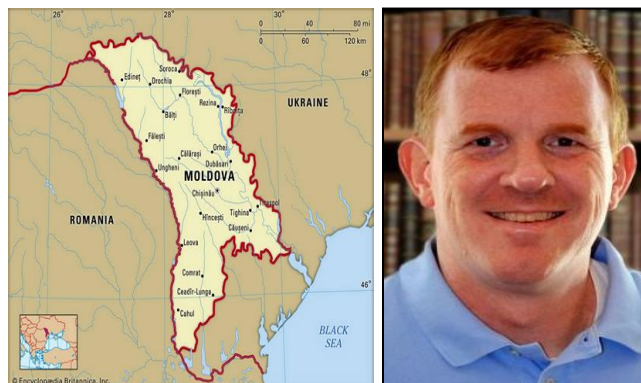
- Translate 9 courses and 30 books into French, translate courses into Russian, continue to translate radio content into French, record radio content into English and French, continue supporting 3 church plants in Bulgaria, continue supporting Kuyper Center’s outreach to professors, students in countries in Central and S. America.

Complete upgrade of S. Sudan radio station, upgrade Grenada radio station to reach all of Grenada, increase program content, start new radio station in a third country.

Rev. Dave Crum taught on the Holy Spirit and Salvation in Chula Vista, California in September.



Rev. Clif Daniell lectured on chapters 32 (Of the State of Men after Death, and of the Resurrection of the Dead) and 33 (Of the Last Judgment) of the Westminster Confession of Faith in Edinet, Moldova in September.



John Burke taught Biblical Theology in Medellin, Colombia, Systematic Theology I in Cochabamba, Bolivia in November, and Systematic Theology II in Tabasco, Mexico in December.



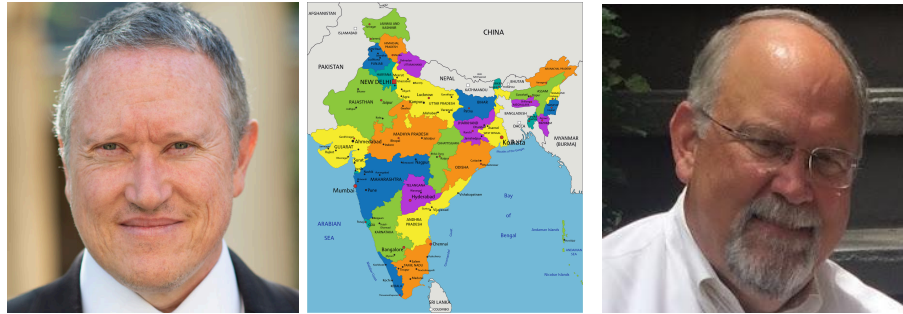
Pastor Maxito continued teaching pastors and aspiring pastor students in Jacmel, Haiti in the Bachelors and Masters degree programs in Theological Studies in the MINTS curriculum. He taught Intro to Christian Counseling in October, Apologetics and Christian Ed in November, and Western Mind in December.



Dr. Joe Fitzpatrick taught Intro to the Old Testament in Quito, Ecuador in October.



Pastor Isaías Martínez taught Reformed Bibliology and Hermeneutics in October and November, Biblical Counseling in November, and Family Discipleship and Biblical Doctrines of Evangelism in December, to rural church pastors in Nicaragua. Ivan Tomassini and Dr. Richard Smith joined him in November to teach a seminar on Callings in Signatepeque, Honduras, and Biblical Worldview, A Biblical-Reformed Anthropology, Common Grace in the Reformed Tradition, Wisdom, Seminars on specific Biblical passages, and Loving God with the Mind, in Nicaragua.



Phil Schrock taught Children's Ministry Training in Pune and Visakhapatnam, and Dr. Bruce Wilson lectured on the Holy Spirit to 50 students via Zoom in India, all in December.
