2025 Progress Report

Teaching

Teaching Missions International is on schedule to teach 73 courses/seminars by the end of 2025, an increase from the 46 classes taught in 2024. Classes were taught in 20 countries on 4 continents with approximately 2,500 participants made up of pastors and church leaders.

Hosted a conference in Southeastern Europe in Moldova with 67 attendees (up from the 31 in 2024). Made up of pastors representing 15 countries throughout the region. This year's seminar topics were: Hermeneutics in the Pentateuch, Hermeneutics in the Prophets, Hermeneutics in the Gospels, Hermeneutics in the Pauline Epistles, Biographical/Historical Sketch (Samuel Rutherford), and Panel Discussion: Correct Exegesis for Topical Subjects

Signed a partnership with Miami International Seminary (MINTS) to become a virtual study center for Haiti and Europe, with further discussion focused on Africa, Western Europe and Nepal. TMI will conduct classes for MINTS via virtual media and face to face, translating courses and readings into French and other languages, recording audio lectures and conducting registrar responsibilities for the Master of Arts in Theological Studies (MATS) and Bachelors of Arts in Theological Studies (BATS) degree programs, with 31 students currently enrolled.

Translation / Literature

Made 100 translations of **Reformed** content into French and 150 audio recordings for radio broadcast.

Distributed over 1,300 reformed books in English and French in various countries.

Distributed hundreds of Reformed witnessing tracts in Haitian Creole in Haiti.

Signed an agreement with Ligonier to translate Reformed Study Bible notes into Bulgarian and kicked off the project. We are currently only 2% through for what will be a 5-7 year project.

Ministry Support

Provided 17 computers for Haitian bible school students.

Supported operation of Kuyper Center to present Christian Worldview as outreach to professors, students in Buenos Aires, Argentina, Nicaragua, Honduras.

Continued to support three church plants, in Ruse (1) and Plovdiv (2), Bulgaria, all of which have grown spiritually and numerically.

Radio Outreach

Provided a radio transmitter to HOPE 103.1 FM radio Grenada to replace transmitter struck by lightning. Continued to provide HOPE 103.1 FM radio Grenada with Reformed theology content and began work on a project to expand the radio station to reach all of Grenada.

Obtained license and frequency and began expansion of a radio station in Juba, South Sudan for greater population reach.

Opportunities/Goals for 2026:

Teaching

Increase the number of theological courses taught from 74 to 85 (often includes professor transportation, room and board, and in some countries, e.g. Haiti, India, and Uganda, a stipend for each person who attends to cover their loss of time earning funds for their families).

Expand SE Europe Reformed Conference (to be held in Durres, Albania 2026). With this year's conference success we have had a significant increase in potential attendees reaching out to us. Therefore we are preparing to handle over 90 attendees for 2026 (versus the 67 we had this year), if the Lord so blesses.

Explore the possibility of sponsoring a Reformed Theological Conference in Africa.

Explore the possibility of sponsoring a Reformed Theological Conference in Nepal.

Explore expanding Haitian Bible College to another campus (either Cap Haitien or alternate site).

Translation / Literature

Distribute 1,500 theological books to various countries (increase from 1,300 in 2025).

Continue to work with Ligonier in translation of Reformed Study Bible notes into Bulgarian with a goal to have completed 17% of the project by year end (up from 2% in 2025).

Translate 9 courses into French.

Translate 30 books into French.

Translate courses into Russian.

Ministry Support

Continue supporting 3 church plants in Bulgaria.

Continue to translate radio content into French, record in English and French.

Continue supporting operation of Kuyper Center to present Christian Worldview as outreach to professors, students in Buenos Aires, Argentina, other countries in Central and S. America.

Radio Outreach

Complete construction and expansion of equipment of the radio station in Juba, South Sudan to reach a larger population.

Upgrade radio station in Grenada to reach all of Grenada, increasing the listening population.

Start radio stations in St. Vincent and Jacmel, Haiti.

Add 150 new radio devotions to the existing 425+ devotions

Expand radio content to include sermons, courses, and other content.
